01 Classification & Gap Analysis

Essential / Important determination per Article 3, maturity assessment against Article 21.

02 Compliance Roadmap

Control prioritisation, timeline, budget, maturity KPIs.

03 ICSSO Appointment & Framework

Role profile, formal appointment act, reporting duties to ΥΑΣΠΕ.

04 Board Resolution & Policies

Board decision, cybersecurity policies, supervised entities register.

05 Incident Readiness

Early (24h), initial (72h) and final (1 month) notification procedures.

06 Board Training

Director briefings — personal liability, oversight, obligations.
